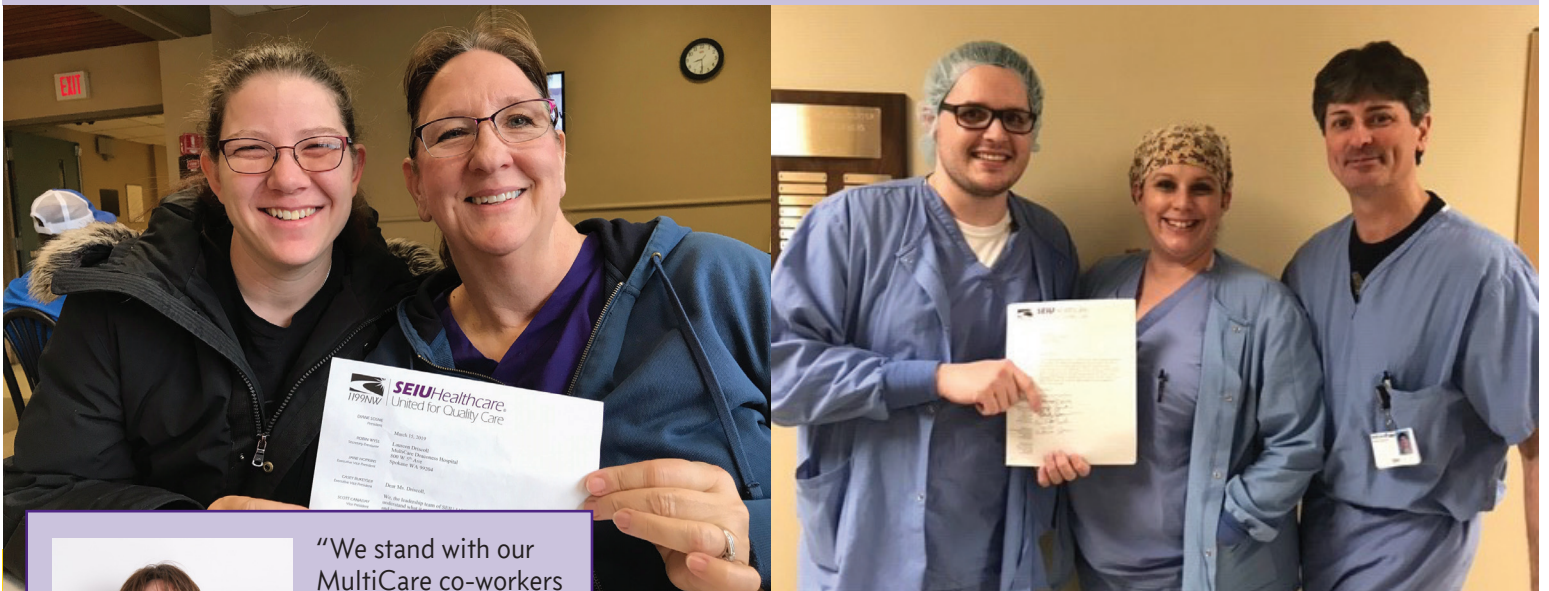


Solidarity across the State: United for Better Auburn

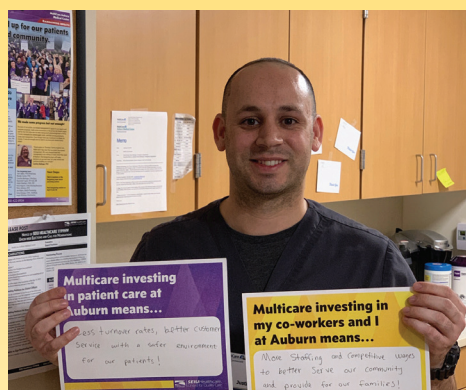
We are Continuing to Unite for Better Contract
