

# Start a New Career: MA Apprenticeship



Join the growing and in-demand field of Medical Assisting through a unique training opportunity and earn while you learn.

## Program Overview

The MA Apprenticeship Program is a full-time, paid position (with benefits) that combines 288 hours of classroom learning with 2000 hours of on-the-job training.

- **Obtain your MA Certification:** this program prepares students to take the Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) test through the National Healthcareer Association (NHA), achieving the MA-C state credential.
- **A full-time job at Kaiser Permanente:** Apprentices are guaranteed a position at Kaiser Permanente (2-year service commitment required).
- **Open to internal and external applicants:** applications are open to all; current SEIU service bargaining unit members will maintain seniority.

## Eligibility

- Applicants must be 18 or older, have a HS Diploma or equivalent, and be able to perform the physical duties of the role.
- Upon entry into the program, applicants must pass an assessment or have completed courses in College Math and English (tutoring available through SEIU Training Fund).
- Apprentices must be available to work at KP clinic sites in one of the following districts: Snohomish, Seattle, East King, South King, Kitsap, Tahoma, and Olympia.
