Members Win Break & Overtime Protections for ALL Hospitals, Nursing & Techs with No 8-Hour Restriction!

Because of our massive member activism, we won patient safety legislation which ensures break and overtime protections for ALL hospitals, nursing staff and techs, without an 8-hour restriction. We rallied in the state Capitol, spoke out in the press and social media, sent over 7,000 emails, made thousands of phone calls and talked directly to our lawmakers.

The state House and Senate have passed the bill by wide margins in bipartisan votes, and now it's headed to Governor Inslee's desk to sign.
