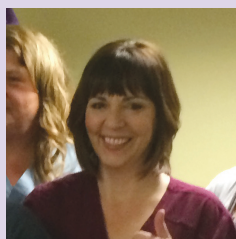


Our Unity Is Our Power

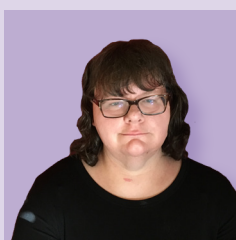
