WHEN WE FIGHT, WE WIN!

The stronger our membership, the more we can win. Through our unity during the last contract bargaining, we achieved many victories including:

- ☑ All job classes to see wage increases between 9%-16% during the two-year contract
- RN total wage increases from December 2020 through December 2021 are between 15%-20%
- ☑ Raised RN night shift differentials to \$4.00
- ☑ Raised NAC night shift differentials to \$2.00
- ☑ Supplemental received the same increases as benefited employees
