This month, hundreds of us working as nurses for the state of Washington unanimously voted to take big public action if needed to ensure a contract that respects us, protects us and pays us fairly!

We went to the bargaining table yesterday with our message of unity. Together we made some good progress. Our priority is to settle a contract that values us, the patients we care for, and clients we serve. We deserve to be paid for the work we do. Many of us work in dangerous facilities and some of us have injuries and illnesses from our jobs that are preventing us from coming back to work. We know that we are united and ready to take action. Our voice matters. We will show up for each other and the communities we serve.

Management can show us we are all valued by meaningfully addressing the issues we have raised to them and provided solutions for, including the staffing crisis, unsafe worksites, increasing workloads, dangerously low recruitment and retention, and unfair working conditions.



We have made great progress but the fight is not over!
