United in the Mission, United in One Union!

On-call staff are moving forward with joining our coworkers in SEIU Healthcare 1199NW at DESC! Yesterday, we took our first step towards officially being recognized as union members by filing our confidential union authorization petition with the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) to request an election!

At DESC, on-calls play a critical role filling in where there are staffing holes, but we don't have the same union rights and protections as our full-time coworkers. On-call and full-time staff work side-by-side to serve our clients' needs — we ALL deserve a seat at the table when decisions get made!

That's why a majority of on-calls have signed a petition to join SEIU Healthcare 1199NW and unite with full-time staff in one union at DESC. Yesterday, a delegation of on-calls and union members delivered a statement to the office of our Executive Director, Daniel Malone, to share with him our vision for growing collaboration between management and staff.

"I've been an on-call residential counselor at DESC for almost three years. I questioned early on — why do we not have a union? We deserve the same rights and representation as full-time staff. I've lost good coworkers — positive, amazing people who were great to work with and great with clients — because we don't have the same protections as our full-time union coworkers. That's why I'm so excited on-calls are finally getting this opportunity! To me, being union means having each other's backs, that's why I'm voting yes!"

The insight into the needs, misdeeds, and pleads of multiple buildings, being able to see the scope of DESC through a wide-angle lens and bringing that perspective to the bargaining process? On-call staff have a unique and valuable perspective that is exactly what we need to continue to win victories in working conditions at an ever-expanding agency.
