Q: What is SEIU Healthcare 1199NW?

A: SEIU Healthcare 1199NW is over 30,000 healthcare and behavioral health workers united across Washington State and Montana. We stand together to advocate for quality care and for good jobs.



Q: How much are dues?

A: Dues are 1.8% or \$18 for every \$1,000 you earn - you only pay dues on the hours you work at DESC. Dues are used to support our union organization through assistance in organizing, negotiationg, representation, legal, research, policy and advocacy work for our contract and union organization at DESC and our larger union. They are set by our entire membership and can only change with a membership-wide vote.
