"In our historic second union contract, we won a 11.5% wage increase for all RNs! We also won stronger language for our Nurse Staffing Committee. The NSC gives us the ability to have 1:1 review of Assignment Despite Objection (ADO) forms with our directors, so we are more

informed to problem-solve staffing issues with

management. We also won language to have access to our workplace to distribute union materials, meet with members and have meeting space, which were gray areas before.

3 things to do NOW

1 Know your contract.

Our contract lays out our wages and benefits along with our rights and responsibilities. Each of us needs to know our contract and make sure management adheres to it. Our contract is only as strong as we are at enforcing it. Scan the QR code and find your digital contract here:

2 Know your delegate.

Delegates are nominated from departments/units to be our representatives, both within our union and to management. If management is not following the contract, a delegate can help resolve the problem. Delegates are listed on our website.
