The results of the vote are in: we voted unanimously in support of our bargaining priorities.

Winning big requires unity, and this shows that we are starting off right with our bargaining.

We are fighting to win:

- The SEIU Healthcare 1199NW Multi-Employer Training Fund
- A minimum wage of no less than \$25/hour by the end of the contract
- Parity on premiums and differentials
- Stronger protections from layoffs/restructures
- Making sure our newly organized union siblings in the patient transport department enjoy all the same contractual protections as the rest of us.
